### 7TH GRADE

#### World Language

- Using a pen-pal system and Pear Deck for vocabulary practice that reinforces the improvements in the domains of writing and reading. Cognates are folded into the text for ease of the transition between languages, making connections easier.
- Listening and speaking are improved through Let's Recap for Storytelling and increases in confidence in the target language. <u>Let's Recap</u>

#### Science

Several engineering projects that make use of the concepts learned through the unit to accomplish a specific task.

- In the first project students are given a mixture of materials that have to be separated based on differences in physical properties.
- In the second project students will optimize the design of a hand warmer by completing optimization studies about the quantities of reactants used.

How to create and interpret graphs as well as how to use dimensional analysis to convert units and solve problems.

#### ELA

- Growth in application of vocabulary words/use of context clues to define unknown words
- Allows alignment between Social Studies and Literacy through the context that was selected
- Teachers appreciate the higher expectations that are now set through the use of the curriculum (specifically assessments)
- The curriculum is dynamic and allows teachers to adapt lessons to different learners
- Allows for greater, transparent student accountability
- Better prepares students for the challenges of high school

#### World Language

- The curriculum update reflects more demanding readings for the grade as well as the Honors program, with increasing rigor of verbs and adverbs, including reflexive verbs. Students receive intensive review at more frequent intervals.
- Also, while using a pen-pal system and Quizlet for vocabulary practice, improvements are made in the domains of writing and reading.
- Listening and speaking are improved through the techniques of student directed Storytelling.
- Cognates are folded into the texts to assist in the ease of transition between languages and connections.
